Thank you to those who completed the home learning survey, we had 167 respondents. 94% stated that the daily class zoom videos are supporting learning at home. 99% felt that children have access to a range of different subjects across the curriculum. Class Dojo and the class zoom lessons are the preferred form of communication. 99% of parents/carers felt that the provision in place is at least satisfactory with 94% deeming it to be good/excellent. We have taken feedback on board and will be introducing additional challenge activities for those children who may wish to further extend their learning.
