Broxtowe Warm Home Hub

Nottingham Energy Partnership are a **fuel poverty charity** based in Nottingham City. The Warm Homes Hub scheme is offering a fuel poverty support package for Broxtowe families. The Hub's free and subsidised support includes:

- **Fuel vouchers** to help cover the costs of gas and electricity
- Over the phone **energy switching** support
- Financial support to get **broken or faulty boilers** repaired or replaced
- Heating improvements, such as a **1st time gas central heating system**
- **Home insulation**
- **Benefit checks**
- **Priority Services Register**, which ensures that in the event of a power cut, families with children under the age of 5, family members who rely on medical equipment, or have a serious illness or disability can receive additional support
- Referrals to other organisations for **advice with debt, food parcels** or similar
