**Tramway Village trip – Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> May 2021**

We are very pleased to announce Year 5 will be visiting the Tramway Village. This trip has been organised to support our topic on The Victorian era for summer term and also links perfectly with our Science and History Curriculum in Year 5. The visit will give us a chance to immerse ourselves in the lives of Victorian people and to see how tramways affected society. We have hired a coach to get us to and from the Tramway Village and there is an entry fee. To cover the cost, we are asking for a **voluntary contribution of £11.62 per child** which is payable on [www.schoolmoney.co.uk](http://www.schoolmoney.co.uk). If your child is entitled to Pupil Premium the cost will be a **voluntary contribution of £5.81**, please tick the relevant statement on the Google form.

The children will need to come to school at the usual time and we will be back at school for the end of the day. Full school uniform must be worn - please check the weather forecast and pack a waterproof coat.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch from home (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please). If your child is entitled to free school meals a packed lunch will be provided.

**To ensure our trip is COVID safe**, we have taken extra precautions in the planning of the trip and will be taking extra measures on the day. The Tramway Village have their own COVID guidelines which we will adhere to and they have achieved the "We're Good to Go" industry standard for safety.

To ensure the safety of all, the following has been considered:

- The coach trip will be for our bubble only and the driver will wear appropriate PPE in line with COVID guidance.
- Arriving at the Tramway Village, we will be kept in our own bubble and the visit will be led by Fairfield staff who are within the Year 5 bubble.
- When on a tram journey, the trams have been booked for Fairfield use only and no members of the public will have come into contact with the seating areas we will be using.
- When walking around the site we will be in our own bubble. When taking part in activities, facilities will be cleaned and hand sanitiser used at the beginning and end of our time slot.
- The majority of the trip will be outdoors as the Tramway Village is an open-air museum. If we are able to enter any of the buildings (dependent upon the 17<sup>th</sup> May government update on unlocking the lockdown), we will have a dedicated time slot to be able to see the indoor exhibitions.
