With ideas from WWF, the Reading Challenge focuses on 'taking action' for nature and tackling real-world environmental issues, from plastic pollution and deforestation to wildlife decline and nature loss.

Dinner Money Payments



Kind reminder – there has been a slight change to the layout of SchoolMoney accounts. When logging into your child’s SchoolMoney account it will say, “Payments due – there are no outstanding payments”, please click on the drop down menu in the top left hand corner, click on “Dinners” and you can see your current balance. If you have money outstanding, this will show as a minus figure. You can choose the amount you wish to pay by entering the amount in the green box, click on the “plus sign” and this will add the payment to your trolley, then click on the trolley and go to the checkout.
